

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT OVERDRAFTS AND OVERDRAFT PRIVILEGE FEES

An overdraft occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

1. We have standard overdraft practices that come with your account.
2. We also offer overdraft protection plans, such as a link to another account or a line of credit, which may be less costly than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

- What are the standard overdraft practices that come with my account?

We do authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments via Automated Clearing House (ACH)

We will not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions without your consent.

- ATM transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we do not guarantee that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do not authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

- What fees will I be charged if American Heritage Credit Union pays my overdraft?

Under our standard overdraft practices, we will charge you a fee of:

- \$10 fee per presentment for resulting negative balance less than or equal to \$25 each time we pay an overdraft.
- \$24 fee per presentment for resulting negative balance greater than \$25 each time we pay an overdraft.
- There is no limit on the total Overdraft Privilege Fees per day we will charge.

- What if I want American Heritage Credit Union to authorize and pay overdrafts on my ATM, and everyday debit card transactions?

If you want us to authorize and pay overdrafts on ATM, and everyday debit card transactions:
